

THE STATE ASSOCIATION OF TEXAS PIONEERS

The State Association of Texas Pioneers was founded in 1921.

The purpose of the organization is to:

- *Keep alive Texas history and perpetuate Texas traditions
- *Cultivate friendly relations between the descendants of Texas Pioneers.
- *Support historical museums, institutions, programs and education that carry out the social and charitable purposes of the Association.

The Texas Pioneers maintained an exhibit of early Texas history in the Memorial Hall Museum, 3805 Broadway in San Antonio, Texas for over 70 years. That building was added to the Witte Museum complex. The Pioneers have moved the rest of their artifacts to the State Association of Texas Pioneers Museum and the Pioneer Village in Gonzales, Texas.

Each April the State Association sponsors the Patriotic and Historical Ball held on the first Saturday of Fiesta. For this event, an Honorary Lady Chairman is selected to preside over the festivities, which include a visit from King Antonio, as well as other Fiesta Dignitaries. Texas Pioneers participate in the Battle of Flowers Parade and the Pilgrimage to the Alamo. Other social events for members occur from time to time during the year.

The State Association of Texas Pioneers is a **501(c)(3)** Not for Profit Corporation in the State of Texas. Pioneer Membership is available to those citizens whose ancestors were residents of Texas prior to 1900. Associate Membership is available for those who do not meet the eligibility requirements for Pioneer Membership and are dedicated to supporting the history, values and purpose of the Pioneers. Junior Membership at reduced dues is available for children under 21years old.

Applicants are requested to provide the name and date of residence of their ancestor that lived in Texas prior to 1900 and their relationship to the applicant. It should indicate the county or counties where the person lived. Please indicate the census year that would show the person’s residence in Texas and, if possible, please attach at least a brief family history and a copy of any document (a census record, certificate of birth, death or marriage, etc.). Any spouse and/or children applying for membership should indicate their ancestry as well. If not, they will be considered for Associate Membership (no ancestor information required).

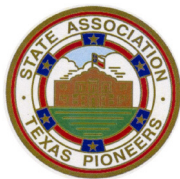
